THE PROGAM

PART 1:

Saturday June 24th

Arrival at Amsterdam or Rotterdam Airport. Get to know your host-family. In the evening, there will be a meet and greet with your Summer camp friends and of course the people of Rotary Alphen Woubrugge.

Sunday June 25th

Enjoy your first real Dutch day, do what the locals do, and take the bike. Destination: our local art gallery, where you will create your own piece of art! In the evening, it is time to enjoy a relaxing dinner with your host family.

Monday June 26th

God created earth, the Dutch made Holland. Today it's polder time! Experience the World Heritage Molenviergang Aarlanderveen. Learn how the Dutch have been keeping their feet dry. This is a unique opportunity to climb a historical windmill and shake hands with the miller himself.

Tuesday June 27th

Enjoy the vibrant city of Rotterdam. Top 10 destination Lonely Planet, and the largest Port of Europe, stretching over a distance of 40 kilometers (25 mi). Get up close to the new harbour in construction: de Tweede Maasvlakte.

Wednesday June 28th

All historical cities in Holland are connected by water. Today we will step on board of a traditional Dutch "sloep". You will probably know the captain, because the ships are owned by members of our own Rotary club. Our destination is Leiden, the city of the famous painter Rembrandt and the oldest university town (1575). Evening at the Rotary club. Will be fun!

Thursday June 29th
