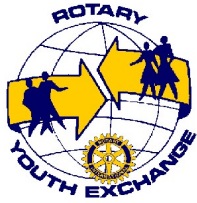

Theme : « **Belgium : Heart of Europe** »

Participants : Girls and boys aged 17-20, sponsored by a certified Rotary Club
All participants are expected to be fully acquainted with the rules of the Youth Exchange Program and to be ambassadors of their countries

Duration : From **July 5th to July 14th, 2019**

Arrival-Departure : Brussels Airport (BRU), Brussels South/Charleroi Airport (CRL) or Brussels South Train Station

Program : Visits to important Belgian cities and regions
A detailed program will be sent to participants in June

Accommodation : Participants will be accommodated by Belgian families and in hostels

Special requirements : - Bring 2 Rotary banners from your sending club
- Ability to swim 100 meters and bike for 25 km

Costs : Camp fee : 150 euros, payable after acceptance
Participants will pay for their travel costs to Belgium and back, and have pocket money along

Clothes: casual, jacket for boys during Rotary meetings

Insurance : Each participant must be fully insured against accidents, sickness and third party liability according to Rotary International Requirements, and to the existence of an agreement or not between his/her home country and Belgium

Language : Participants are expected to have a working knowledge of English and French if possible
